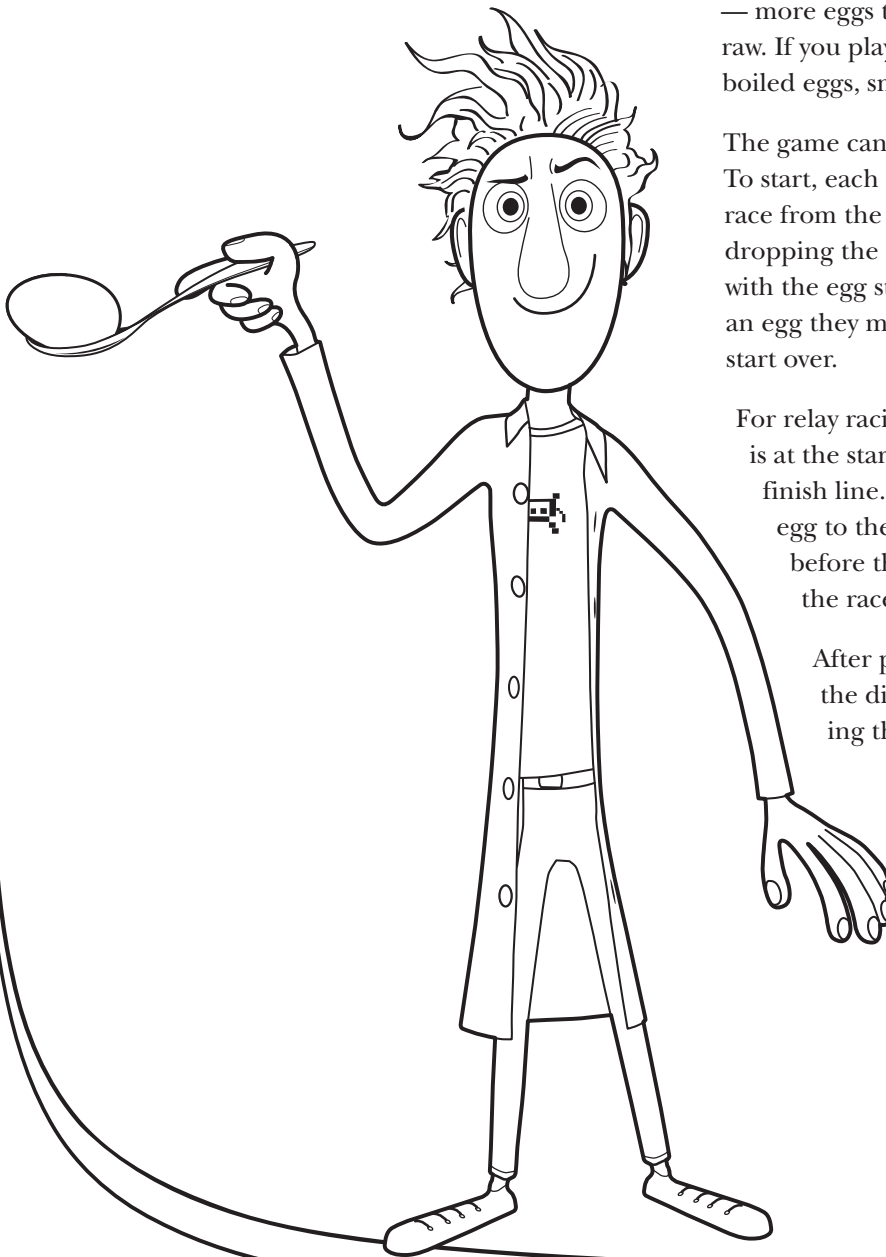


# CLOUDY with a chance of MEATBALLS

## EGG AND SPOON RACE



### How to Play

You will need enough eggs and spoons for all the players — more eggs to account for breakage if you use them raw. If you play indoors, you may want to use hard boiled eggs, small potatoes or ping pong balls.

The game can be played one on one or in team relays. To start, each player places an egg on a spoon and must race from the starting line to the finish line without dropping the egg. The first one to reach the finish line with the egg still on the spoon wins. If a player drops an egg they must go back to the starting point and start over.

For relay racing, divide the teams so half of the team is at the starting point and the other half is at the finish line. Players must hand off their spoon and egg to their teammate on the opposing side before that next player can begin their leg of the race.

After playing a regular game you can increase the difficulty by adding obstacles or changing the course.
